# St. Maurice 55 Plus Ministry

Recognizing the need for a senior's fellowship, the St. Maurice Catholic Women's League launched the Golden Agers Ministry in 2007. It is now known as 55 Plus. Our members range in age from 50 to 97. We meet on Monday afternoons, from 1 to 3 pm, in the atrium for social companionship, a game of cards and refreshments. Currently, we have about 40 regular members with groups playing euchre, fun bridge, and skippo. If there is interest, we could play other games like 99, cribbage, or scrabble. We usually break for coffee or tea and a snack at about 2 pm. Once a month, we celebrate birthdays with cake and special birthday greetings. We also have a special Christmas and an end-of-the-year lunch. We meet from mid-September to early June with a month-long Christmas break. There is no fee to join us. Members give a voluntary donation to show their appreciation, which we use to defray our costs. This year, we gave surplus money to the parish to help pay for the new dishwasher and to our St. Vincent de Paul Society for the Christmas Hamper program.

Lola Hall, a longtime member, is very thankful for our ministry and says, "Thank you all for your hard work to help entertain us" and "ingenuity to make it happen. You make us old folks feel so welcome. "Eileen Rimek commented that "it's rather nice and uplifting and puts a smile on your face". Kathy Birmingham, a new member who recently retired, says, "It's great to meet people and to get out and that she is enjoying everyone's company". Please come and join us on Monday afternoon. 
