

REVIVAL NIGHT

The concept of revival is deeply embedded in the history of the Catholic Church. Throughout pivotal moments in history, the Holy Spirit has consistently inspired repentance, mass conversions, and profound transformations. Pentecost, as described in the Acts of the Apostles, marks the inaugural revival of the Church. From that defining moment, the Holy Spirit continued to be poured out, reviving God's people in crucial times. Various saints, such as Francis of Assisi, Catherine of Siena, and Ignatius of Loyola, led movements that prompted dramatic conversions and drew numerous souls to Christ. In modern times, the Catholic Charismatic Renewal emerged in 1967, swiftly spreading to Catholic communities globally, signifying a powerful modern-day revival in the Catholic Church. Join us for our next Revival Night on Friday, July 19, at 7:00 pm as Fr. Ben leads us in prayer for a revival, a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our



parish. Come, Holy Spirit, come!

POPE FRANCIS' INTENTIONS FOR JULY

Pope Francis has extended an invitation to Christians worldwide to pray for the pastoral care of the sick throughout the month of July 2024. "Let us pray that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick grant the Lord's strength to those who receive it and to their loved ones, and that it may become for everyone an ever more visible sign of compassion and hope."

FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT

On Monday, July 8 in a ceremony called an Ordinary Public Consistory, Pope Francis and the cardinals in Rome will formally approve of the canonization of Carlo Acutis, a 15-year old Italian web designer, making him the Catholic Church's first saint from the millennial generation. A date has not been chosen for the canonization of Acutis who has been referred to as "God's Influencer" because of his work spreading Catholicism online. His canonization will most likely occur in 2025.
