#### SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL



#### **BEWARE OF FRAUDULENT EMAILS!**

Some staff and ministry leaders have received emails supposedly from Fr. Ben, requesting their urgent assistance or asking them to purchase gift cards. Please do not respond to these emails. Just delete them.

Fraudsters use public information available on websites and online bulletins to target individuals, and they try to impersonate staff members. Please keep in mind that:

- No staff member will ever ask you to purchase gift cards.
- All staff will use their St. Maurice email accounts. You can assume it is fraudulent if you receive an email from a Gmail or other account. If you are unsure, check with the office.
- Fraudsters are becoming more sophisticated in their communications. They likely use AI to generate their emails, and they may no longer contain the spelling and grammatical errors that were past giveaways.

Emails coming from our St. Maurice account are encrypted.

We are working hard to set up our new Sunergo platform so that staff and ministry leaders can communicate in a fully encrypted system, so please stay tuned.

#### **40 DAYS FOR LIFE**

In the early 2000s, God spoke to the hearts of co-founders David Bereit, Shawn Carney and their wives about his grave concern for his precious gift of life and how it is being abused. Abortion, once considered by society as a serious error, is now considered a woman's right and is being used as a form of birth control.

The four of them prayed outside their local abortion facility for 40 days, giving rise to the first campaign. Word spread and more and more communities joined in praying outside of abortuaries for the little ones dying inside. 40 Days for Life came to Ottawa in 2008 and has since expanded to Canadian cities from coast to coast. This year, 700+ locations worldwide are participating. In 2017, Ontario Bill 163, the Safe Access to Abortion Services Act, came into effect, and by provincial law, we are not allowed within 50 meters of the abortuary.

We gather daily, between 7 am to 7 pm, on the southwest corner of Queen St. at Bank St. from Sept 25 to Nov 3. We come together to witness to life and pray silently for the little ones who have lost, or will lose, their lives at Ottawa's main abortion facility (located at 65 Bank St). We also pray for the moms who have suffered abortions, the dads who have lost their children, family members, and others impacted by abortion. We pray for those who commit, promote and support abortion – that their hearts will change.

We pray for a Culture of Life in Canada.
