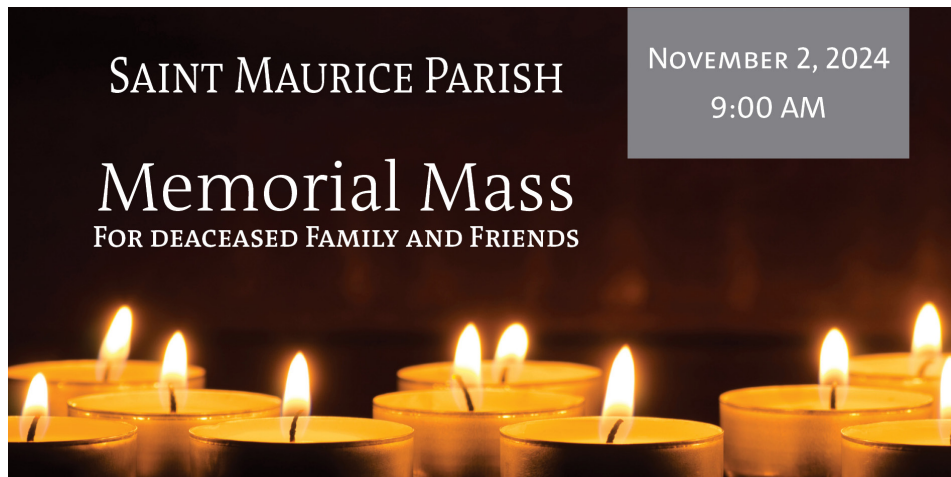
MINISTRY LEADERS SUMMIT
